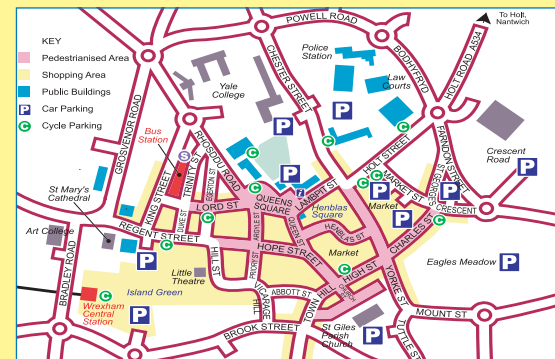

All of Wrexham County Borough Council town centre car parks are pay and display (except Rhosddu Road which is for disabled badge holders only). Ticket machines are located in convenient locations within each car park and tariff boards indicate the charges and parking regulations. Charges apply in all car parks between the hours of 8.00am - 5.00pm Sunday to Saturday inclusive including bank holidays.

## P Season Tickets

Season tickets are available for the following town centre car parks:

People's Market - £200.00 for 6 months (closed Sundays)  
Waterworld - £300.00 for 6 months  
Crescent Road - £168.00 for 6 months

Season tickets allow parking Sunday to Saturday inclusive. Should you wish to apply for a Wrexham County Borough Council season ticket, please contact the Council's Parking Services in the first instance.

## P Disabled Badges

It is free to park without a time limit within any Wrexham County Borough Council town centre car park, as long as a valid blue badge and clock are on display. Blue badge holders can park within a designated disabled bay, or in a standard parking bay. Blue Badge holders can also park on the highway on single or double yellow lines for up to 3 hours **except where there is a loading or unloading ban**. There are also specific times when badge holders can access the pedestrianised areas of Wrexham town centre. Please check signs regarding access.

## P Motorcycle Parking

There is dedicated motorcycle parking in Waterworld, St George's Crescent, St Giles and Market Street Car Parks.

## P Civil Parking Enforcement

From 1 March 2008, Wrexham County Borough Council took over responsibility from the North Wales Police for managing parking enforcement throughout the County Borough. From that date, Civil Enforcement Officers employed by the Council have patrolled on the streets, as well as in Council Car Parks. The Council's Civil Enforcement Officers will issue Penalty Charge Notices (PCN's) to drivers of vehicles who have parked in contravention of any regulations in force at the time.

## P Parking in Wrexham County Borough

It is your responsibility to park your vehicle correctly. Here are some reminders of where not to park. Don't Park...

- In areas where waiting and loading restrictions are in force at the time;
- In a reserved bay (e.g. for blue badge holders) without correctly displaying a valid permit;
- At a bus stop or in a bus lane during prohibited times;
- On mandatory zig-zag lines outside a school or by pedestrian crossings;
- On the pavement or grass verges behind waiting restrictions in force at the time;
- In a pay and display space without paying the correct amount for the duration of your stay;
- For longer than any waiting restriction or return to the space within the stated time limit;

If you are not sure, check what's on the sign which applies to the place where you are thinking of parking.

## P Dispensations

There may be special occasions when you need to park on yellow lines or in parking bays for longer than the time allowed. A dispensation may be available for this. Please contact the Council's Parking Services in the first instance.

## P Penalty Charge Notices (PCN)

If you think the PCN shouldn't have been issued, write to the Wales Penalty Processing Partnership (the address will be on the back of the PCN) saying why you believe it was incorrectly issued. Please enclose any additional evidence i.e. pay and display tickets. If the PCN hasn't been cancelled and you are still not satisfied you have the right to appeal to the independent Parking Adjudication Service.
