

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT BOUNDARY COMMISSION FOR WALES
LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972
REVIEW OF ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE COUNTY BOROUGH
OF WREXHAM**

On 20 June 2011 the Local Government Boundary Commission for Wales have submitted to the Welsh Government a report containing their Final Proposals in respect of the review of the electoral arrangements for the County Borough of Wrexham.

The report and accompanying schedules contain proposals for a council of 52 members and 39 electoral divisions.

On receipt of the report, the Welsh Government may, if it thinks fit, make an order giving effect to any proposals made to it by the Commission either as submitted or with modifications. Any order giving effect to such proposals shall not be made until after the expiry of six weeks from the day on which proposals were submitted to the Welsh Government.

The report has been published and copies together with a map are on deposit at the offices of the Wrexham County Borough Council and at the offices of the Commission and will be available for inspection until the expiration of six months after the making of any order giving effect to the proposals, or after notification by the Welsh Government that it does not propose to give effect to the proposals.

Arrangements are being made to place copies of the report in each public library in the County Borough of Wrexham and a limited number will be available on request from the Secretary of the Commission at Caradog House, 1-6 St Andrews Place, Cardiff, CF10 3BE.

DEDDF LLYWODRAETH LEOL 1972
AROLWG O'R TREFNIADAU ETHOLIADOL AR GYFER BWRDEISTREF
SIROL WRECSAM**

Ar 20 Mehefin 2011 mae'r Comisiwn Ffiniau Llywodraeth Leol i Gymru wedi cyflwyno adroddiad i Llywodraeth Cymru yn cynnwys eu Cynigion Terfynol yn ymwneud â'r arolwg o'r trefniadau etholiadol ar gyfer Bwrdeistref Sirol Wrecsam.

Mae'r adroddiad a'r atodiadau amgaeedig yn cynnwys cynigion ar gyfer cyngor o 52 o aelodau a 39 o ranbarthau etholiadol.

Ar ôl derbyn yr adroddiad, gall Llywodraeth Cymru, os gwêl fod hynny'n briodol, wneud gorchymyn i weithredu unrhyw gynigion a wneir iddo gan y Comisiwn naill ai fel y'u cyflwynwyd neu gydag addasiadau. Ni ddylai unrhyw orchymyn i weithredu cynigion o'r fath gael ei wneud nes bod chwe wythnos wedi mynd heibio ers y dyddiad y cyflwynwyd y cynigion i'r Llywodraeth Cymru.

Mae'r adroddiad wedi ei gyhoeddi a bydd copïau ohono a map yn swyddfeydd Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Wrecsam ac yn swyddfeydd y Comisiwn a byddant ar gael i'w harchwilio am hyd at chwe mis ar ôl i unrhyw orchymyn i weithredu'r cynigion gael ei wneud, neu ar ôl i Llywodraeth Cymru hysbysu nad yw'n bwriadu gweithredu'r cynigion.

Mae trefniadau hefyd yn mynd rhagddynt i osod copïau o'r adroddiad ymhob llyfrgell gyhoeddus yn Bwrdeistref Sirol Wrecsam a bydd nifer cyfyngedig ar gael drwy wneud cais amdanynt, gan Ysgrifennydd y Comisiwn yn Tŷ Caradog, 1-6 Plas St Andreas, Caerdydd, CF10 3BE.

Dylid cyflwyno unrhyw gynrychioliadau pellach sy'n ymwneud â materion yn yr adroddiad hwn cyn gynted â phosibl, a beth bynnag erbyn 1 Awst 2011, i Y Tîm Democratiaeth, Yr Is-adran Polisi Llywodraeth Leol, Llywodraeth Cymru, Parc Cathays, Caerdydd, CF10 3NQ.
