



**Statutory notice to establish a new Welsh-medium Community primary School  
School Standards and Organisations (Wales) Act 2013**

**WREXHAM COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL**

Notice is given in accordance with section 41 of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 and the School Organisation Code that Wrexham County Borough Council, having consulted such persons as required, propose to establish a new seedling Welsh-medium Primary school to be maintained by Wrexham County Borough Council, sharing the site of Hafod Y Wern CP School at Deva Way, Wrexham LL13 9HD on a temporary basis from September 2019 with subsequent transfer to the site of Borrass Park CP School at Borrass Park Road, Wrexham LL12 7TH expected by September 2021 subject to completion of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century School building works at Borrass Park CP School. The school will eventually accommodate boys and girls aged three to eleven years.

Wrexham County Borough Council undertook a period of consultation before deciding to publish this proposal. It is proposed to implement the proposal on a phased basis commencing September 2019 as follows:

Phase 1 – On 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019 the school will be established and up to 15 pupils admitted to Nursery and up to 15 pupils admitted to Reception.

Phase 2 – On 1<sup>st</sup> September 2020 up to 15 pupils will be admitted to Nursery and up to 15 pupils admitted to Reception. The existing pupils in reception will progress to Year 1.

Phase 3 – On 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 up to 30 pupils will be admitted to Nursery and up to 30 pupils admitted to Reception and the existing pupils will progress to Years 1 and 2.

Phase 4 – On 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022 up to 30 pupils will be admitted to Nursery and up to 30 pupils admitted to Reception and the existing pupils will progress to Years 1, 2 and 3.

Phase 5 – On 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023 up to 30 pupils will be admitted to Nursery and up to 30 pupils admitted to Reception and the existing pupils will progress to Years 1, 2, 3 and 4.

Phase 6 – On 1st September 2024 up to 30 pupils will be admitted to Nursery and up to 30 pupils admitted to Reception and the existing pupils will progress to Years 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Phase 7 – On 1st September 2025 up to 30 pupils will be admitted to Nursery and up to 30 pupils admitted to Reception and the existing pupils will progress to Years 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6.

The proposed new school will be a Welsh-medium community primary school. Wrexham County Borough Council, as Local Authority, will be the admission authority. No provision will be made for either selection by aptitude or ability.

The admission number for pupils aged 4/5 at the new school in the first year is 15. It will also be 15 in the second year. It will rise to 30 in the third year and every year thereafter.

15 pupils will be admitted to the Nursery class each year for the first and second years, rising to 30 in the third and subsequent years.

The new school's pupil capacity at the permanent location will be 210 plus 30 part time nursery places.

Transport for pupils shall be dealt with by reference to the Local Authority's School Transport Policy.
