Dear Parent/Carer

Admission to Nursery Classes/Schools for September 2017

The Local Authority (LA) ensures the provision of nursery education within a range of schools. This can be English medium, Welsh medium or an aided or controlled school (*refer to page 4 of 'Parents' Guide to Education Services in Wrexham'*). Nursery provision is offered on the basis of five 2½ hour sessions per week during the school year 2017/2018. The sessions which your child will be able to attend will be made known to you by the headteacher as soon as possible after you have been notified about a nursery school place for your child.

From 3 January 2017 you will be able to make your application and access the Parents' Guide to Education Services 2017/2018, by registering on-line at www.wrexham.gov.uk. You will need an email address to submit your application on-line from your home computer, or by producing a Library card you can also use the facilities at Contact Wrexham and Wrexham Library. Applications can be made through the medium of English or Welsh and will be received directly by the LA. You will be able to access and amend your application up until the published **closing date of 24 February 2017**.

Should you prefer to submit a paper application form, these can be downloaded and printed from the Wrexham website, or alternatively collected from Contact Wrexham, 16 Lord Street, Wrexham, LL11 1LG. **Paper applications must be returned directly to the Local Authority Admissions Service, Lampit Street, Wrexham, LL11 1AR.**

The Admitting Authority will admit pupils up to the school's admission number (*this number is shown in the school list in the 'Parents' Guide to Education Services in Wrexham'*). If more applications are received than there are available places, the LA's oversubscription criteria will be applied to decide the allocations. **Late applications** will be dealt with after all those that have been submitted by **24 February 2017**, it is very important for you to meet the deadline referred to as you may have less opportunity to be allocated to your preferred school if your application is late.

If you have expressed a preference for a community or a voluntary controlled school, your application will be considered by the LA. Alternatively, if you have expressed a preference for a Catholic or Church in Wales aided school, your application will be considered by the governing body of that school, you are advised to contact these schools directly for further information before submitting your application to the LA.

Parents are reminded that if their child is currently in an early education entitlement class in a school, there is no guarantee of a place in nursery at that school as a separate formal nursery application must be made.

It will take some time for the allocation process to be completed, but you will be informed by **12 May 2017** whether or not your child has been allocated a place at your preferred school. Although the admitting authority will consider parental preferences when allocating places, you are reminded that, should you not be allocated a place at your preferred nursery, there is no formal right to appeal against this decision.

The Local Authority will check the address provided on your application against the records we hold for your child and we may request information and evidence from you if they differ. We may also check council tax records. If you have not provided your council tax reference number on your application we may write to ask you to provide additional proof of your address.

For allocation purposes, any offer of a school place is based on where your child lives at the end of the allocation period and is conditional on your living at that address, unless you have notified us of, and we have accepted, a subsequent move.

Occasionally, issues relating to a child's 'home address' are brought to my attention after school places have been allocated. In such cases, I am obliged to carry out further investigations concerning a child's 'home address' and in doing so, I may ask parents/carers to provide official documentation as evidence confirming a child's 'home address'. Parents/carers are advised that a child's school place may be lawfully withdrawn if the information given on their application is subsequently found to be fraudulent or misleading. The consequence of this could be that there may no longer be a place available for the child at their next nearest school. **If two parents cannot agree which school/schools they prefer, they must seek independent legal advice, and if necessary an appropriate court order, before submitting a single application to the LA.**

If your child has a disability which could affect his/her progress and participation in school life, you must state this when making your application and provide any supporting evidence, for example a letter from a registered health professional such as a Doctor or Social Worker.

If your child has a Statement of Special Educational Needs, the LA will try its best to allow your preference of nursery/primary school but it has to make sure that the school can meet your child's needs fully. After your application has been received, an LA Officer will write to you and may wish to arrange a meeting to discuss your child's primary education.

You are reminded that transport is not provided for children of nursery school age except in exceptional circumstances. Details about the Transport Policy are set out in the County Borough's 'Parents' Guide to Education Services in Wrexham'. **Please note, also, that admission to a nursery class at a particular school does not guarantee a future place for your child at the reception class in that school as a separate formal application must be made.**
