



**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION AND COMING INTO OPERATION OF PUBLIC
PATH DIVERSION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 119**

**The County Borough of Wrexham (Public Footpath Number 39
In the Community of Llansantffraid Glyn Ceiriog)
Public Path Diversion Order 2010**

On 18 day of July 2011 the above-named Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 was confirmed by the Welsh Ministers.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule below and as shown on the Order map.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order map has been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Guildhall, Wrexham and at Pontfadog Post Office, Pontfadog, Llangollen from 9.00 am to 4.30 pm Mondays to Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be obtained free of charge from the Guildhall, Wrexham.

This Order comes into force on 30 November 2011 but if any person aggrieved by the Order want to question its validity or that of any provision contained in the Order, on the grounds that is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, pursuant to paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, he or she may make application to the High Court within six weeks from 3 November 2011.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

That part of Glyntraian footpath 39 shown by a bold continuous line on the Order Plan attached to this Notice, commencing from point A (SJ 1994 3570) on the Order Plan attached to this Notice and continuing generally north for approximately 90 metres to point H (SJ 1996 3579) then generally north-east and east for approximately 85 metres to point J (SJ 2003 3581) then east north-east for approximately 50 metres to point K (SJ 2008 3583) then south-east through the farm yard for approximately 25 metres to point L (SJ 2009 3581) then generally north-east along the farm entrance track for approximately 80 metres to point G (SJ 2017 3584).

PART 2
DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath shown by a bold continuous line with short bars at intervals commencing from point A (SJ 1994 3570) on the Order Plan attached to this Notice and continuing generally north north-east on the western side of the field boundary for approximately 100 metres to point B (SJ 1999 3578) then generally north for approximately 55 metres to a field boundary at point C (SJ 2000 3584) then generally north north-east and east south-east through the disused Cae-Deicws Quarry for approximately 80 metres to point D (SJ 2005 3589) then generally east south-east along a farm track for approximately 90 metres to point E (SJ 2013 3586) then east between two farm buildings for approximately 35 metres to point F (SJ 2016 3586) then south south-east for approximately 15 metres to join the entrance track to the farm at point G (SJ 2017 3584) as shown on the Order plan attached to this Notice.

Width: Width: 3 metres between SJ 1994 3570 (point A on the Order Plan attached to this Notice) and SJ 2017 3584 (point G on the Order Plan attached to this Notice)
