NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER

The County Borough of Wrexham
(Public Footpath No 45 in the Community of Ruabon)
Public Path Diversion Order 2007

On 31 October 2007, Wrexham County Borough Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the Public Footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Notice to a line described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Notice.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Guildhall, Wrexham and the Post Office, 1A New High Street, Ruabon during normal office/opening hours. Copies of the Order and map may be obtained free of charge from the Guildhall, Wrexham.

The Order comes into force on the 1 November 2007, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 1 November 2007 make an application to the High Court.

SCHEDULE

Part 1

Description of site of existing path or way

That part of public footpath No 45 in the Community of Ruabon in the County Borough of Wrexham, of undefined width, from the foot of the Lady Steps at grid reference SJ 30368 43706 in a southwesterly and then generally westerly direction to the highway at Tanylan, grid reference SJ 30319 43697, a total distance of 51 metres, as shown by the bold black continuous line between points A and B on the map attached to the Order.

Part 2

Description of site of new path or way

A public footpath in the Community of Ruabon in the County Borough of Wrexham, that is a path over which the public has a right of way on foot only, from the foot of the Lady Steps at

grid reference SJ 30368 43706, in a southwesterly direction for 13 metres, continuing in a northwesterly direction for 5 metres, then in a southwesterly direction for 24 metres and then in a west southwesterly direction for 8 metres, a total distance of 50 metres, to the highway at Tanylan, grid reference SJ 30328 43682 as shown by the bold black broken line between points A, C, D, E and F on the map contained in the Order. The footpath has a width of 2.0 metres from A to C; between 1.0 and 0.9 metres from C to D; between 1.3 and 1.4 metres from D for a distance of 3 metres (steps) and then 1.5 metres to E and to the highway at F. There are steps between points A to C, C to D and D to E and the path passes underneath the building known as Llys y Nant between D and E.
