



**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION AND COMING INTO OPERATION OF PUBLIC
PATH DIVERSION ORDER
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257
AND PARAGRAPH 7 OF SCHEDULE 14**

**The County Borough of Wrexham (Public Footpath Number 112
In the Community of Ruabon)
Public Path Diversion Order 2011**

On 24 day of August 2011 the Wrexham County Borough Council confirmed and certified the above Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed and certified is to divert the public footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Notice to a line described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Notice.

A copy of the confirmed and certified Order and the Order map may be seen at the Guildhall, Wrexham and the Post Office, 1A New High Street, Ruabon during normal office/opening hours. Copies of the Order and plan may be obtained free of charge from the Guildhall, Wrexham.

This Order came into force on 24 August 2011 but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under Section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OF WAY

That part of public footpath 112 in the Community of Ruabon shown by a bold continuous line commencing from point A (SJ 3226 4454) on the Order plan and continuing west for approximately 121 metres to the field boundary at point B (SJ 3214 4454) on the Order plan then west north-west for approximately 200 metres to the field boundary at point C (SJ 3196 4462) on the attached Order plan.

PART 2
DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath shown by a bold continuous line with short bars at intervals commencing from point A (SJ 3226 4454) on the Order plan and continuing generally west for approximately 113 metres to a point just to the southwest of the oak tree on the field boundary at point D (SJ 3215 4455) on the Order plan then west north-west for approximately 204 metres to a point just to the northeast of the oak tree on the field boundary at point E (SJ 3196 4464) on the attached Order plan.

Width: 2 metres between point A (SJ 3226 4454) on the Order plan and point E (SJ 3196 4464) on the Order plan.
