What is the rural TaxiBus Scheme?

The Wrexham County Borough Council rural TaxiBus scheme is designed to provide flexible public transport connections for the more isolated communities, that are not located along conventional public transport routes.

How does the TaxiBus scheme operate?

A TaxiBus journey can be made, enabling persons in the qualifying area to travel to Wrexham, Whitchurch or other approved neighbouring villages. Likewise journeys can be made by persons to the qualifying area for reasons such as visiting friends, or for other social activities.

Transport is provided using a local Taxi & Private Hire Company, operating on behalf of Wrexham County Borough Council.

How do I use the TaxiBus service?

You will need to book your journey in advance, no less than one hour before you wish to travel. Return bookings and repeat block bookings can be made at the time of booking.
