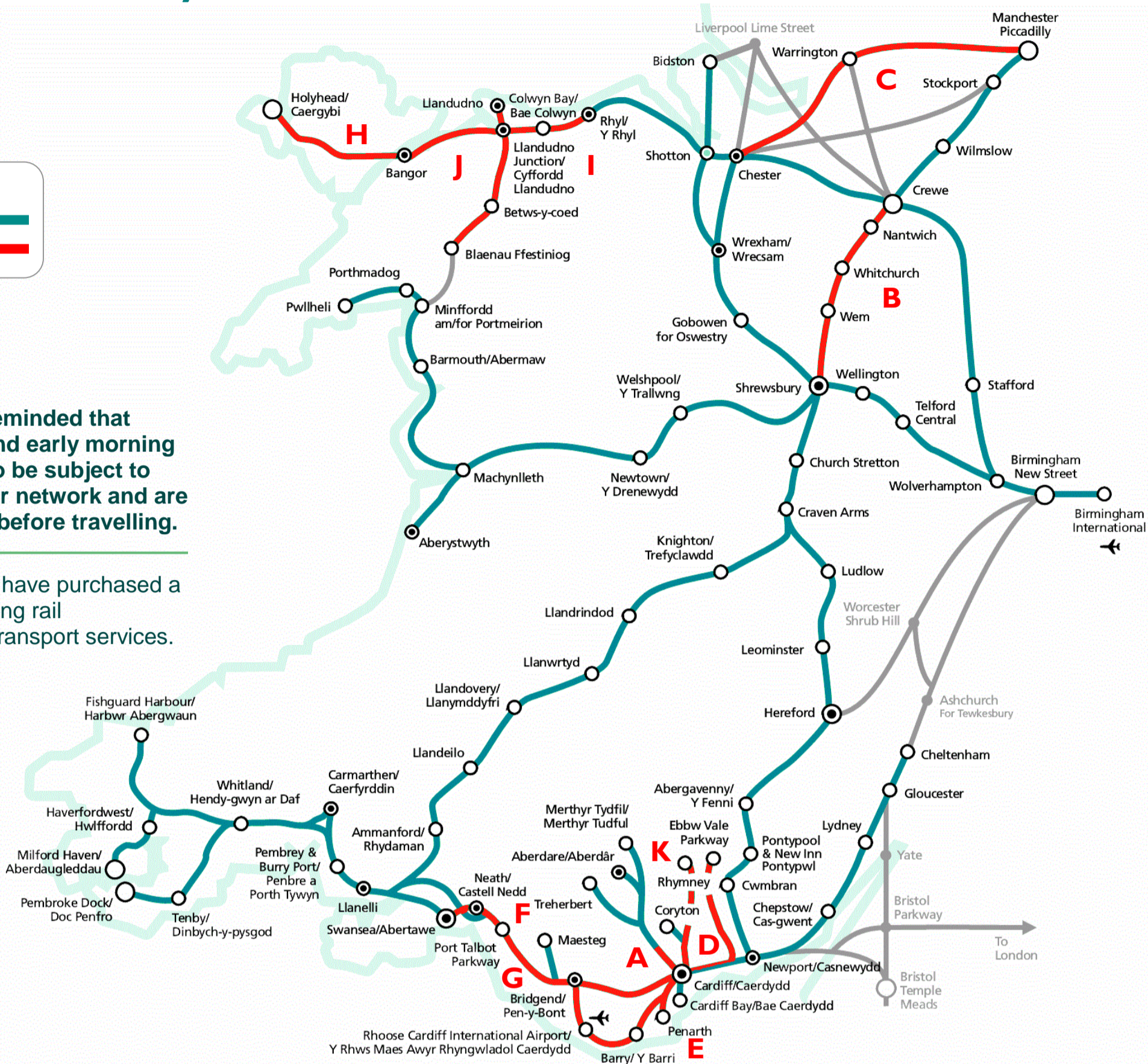

A Cardiff Central to Radyr

Saturday 7th and Sunday 8th January
 Sunday 29th January until 1615

On the above dates train services between Cardiff Central and Aberdare / Merthyr Tydfil / Treherbert will be diverted via the City Line and are unable to call at Cardiff Queen Street, Cathays, and Llandaf. Road transport will operate between Cardiff Central and Radyr, serving Cardiff Queen Street, Cathays, and Llandaf in both directions.

B Crewe to Shrewsbury

Saturday 7th and Sunday 8th January

On the above dates trains between West Wales / Cardiff Central and Crewe / Manchester Piccadilly / Holyhead will be diverted and unable to serve stations between Shrewsbury and Crewe. Road transport will operate between Shrewsbury and Crewe serving all stations via Wem in both directions.

C Chester to Manchester Piccadilly via Warrington Bank Quay

Sundays 8th, 15th, 22nd and 29th January

On the above dates trains between Holyhead / Llandudno / Chester and Manchester Piccadilly will be unable to serve intermediate stations via Warrington Bank Quay with trains being diverted between Chester and Manchester Piccadilly via an alternative route. Road transport will operate serving Helsby, Frodsham, Runcorn East, Warrington Bank Quay, Earlestown, Newton le Willows and Manchester Oxford Road in both directions.

D Cardiff Central to Ebbw Vale Parkway

Sunday 9th October until 1715

On the above date trains between Cardiff Central and Ebbw Vale Parkway will be replaced completely with road transport serving all stations via Newbridge in both directions until 1715.

E Cardiff Central to Barry Island / Bridgend via VoG / Penarth

Sundays 8th, 15th, 22nd and 29th January until 1300

On the above dates trains between Cardiff Central and Barry Island / Bridgend via VoG / Penarth will be replaced with road transport throughout serving all stations in both directions until 1300. On the 29th January road transport will continue to operate between Bridgend and Rhoose from 1300 until the close of service serving Llantwit Major in both directions.

F Cardiff Central to Swansea

Sundays 8th, 15th, 22nd, and 29th January

On the above dates trains between Cardiff Central and Swansea / West Wales will be replaced with road transport between Cardiff Central and Swansea serving all stations via Port Talbot Parkway in both directions.

G Bridgend to Port Talbot Parkway

Saturdays 14th (from 1130) and 21st January

On the above dates trains between Cardiff Central and Swansea / West Wales will be replaced with road transport between Bridgend and Port Talbot Parkway serving Pyle in both directions.

H Bangor to Holyhead

Sundays 15th and 22nd January

On the above dates trains between Chester and Holyhead will be replaced with road transport between Bangor and Holyhead serving all stations via Ty Croes in both directions.

I Blaenau Ffestiniog / Rhyl to Llandudno

Saturday 28th January

On the above date trains between Blaenau Ffestiniog / Chester and Llandudno will be replaced with road transport between Blaenau Ffestiniog / Rhyl and Llandudno serving all stations via Llandudno Junction in both directions.

J Rhyl to Holyhead

Saturday 28th and Sunday 29th January

On the above dates trains between Chester and Holyhead will be replaced with road transport between Rhyl and Holyhead serving all stations via Bangor in both directions.

K Cardiff Central to Rhymney / Heath High Level

Sunday 29th January until 1415

On the above date train services to/from the Rhymney Valley will be replaced with road transport serving all stations via Caerphilly and Bargoed in both directions until 1415.
